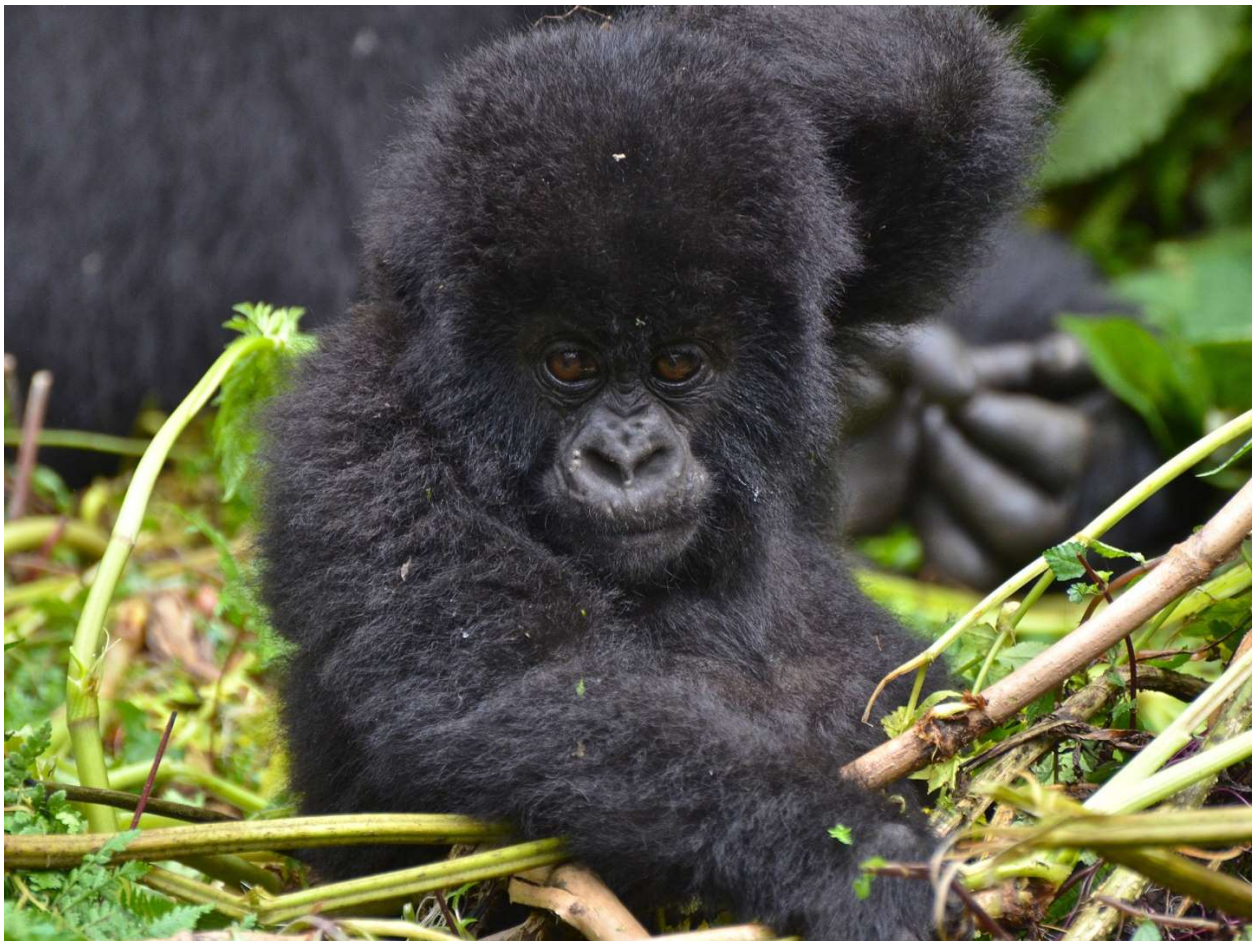


Where to See Wildlife Up Close
